

How to Log in to an ACS Chromebook

A Step-by-Step Guide for Parents

Step 1: Have your wifi network name and password ready.

You will be prompted to connect the Chromebook to your home's wifi network.

If you have trouble logging in, it is most likely because the Chromebook is not connected to the internet.

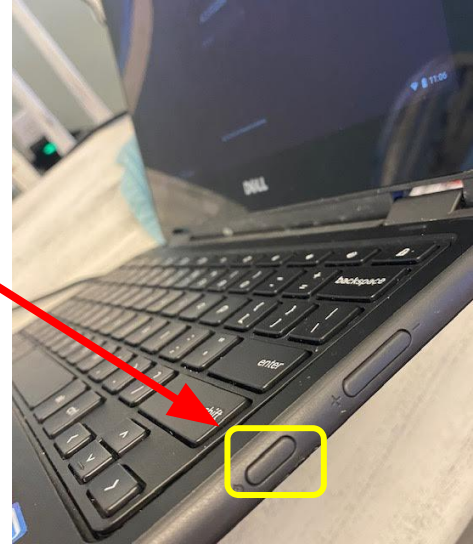
Instructions on how to connect your Chromebook to the internet are found in Step 3 of this tutorial.

Step 2: Turn on your student's Chromebook. Power buttons are one of two places:

1. On the top right of the keyboard.

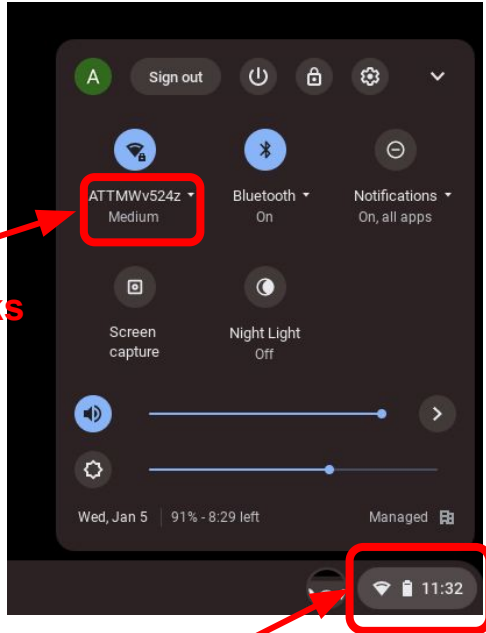


2. On the side of the Chromebook.



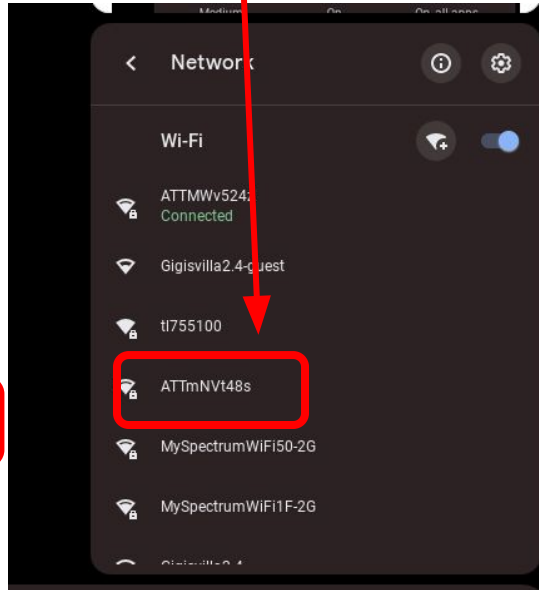
Step 3: Connect the Chromebook to your home wifi network/internet.

2. Click her to view networks

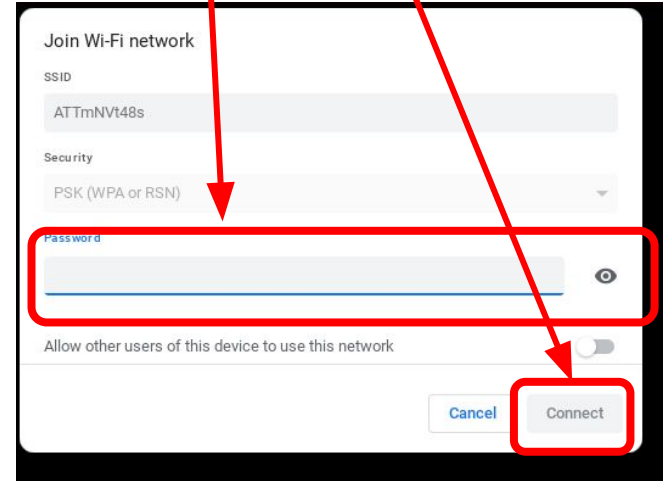


1. Click this in the lower right corner.

3. Click on your home networks name.



4. Enter your wifi password and then click "connect."



Step 4: Enter your student's log in information.

Most students have logged in before, and only need to enter the password.

- Student username is their email address.
 - Example: acsstudent123@student.acsboe.org
- Student password is four digits -acs.
 - Example: 1234-acs

You should be prompted to connect the Chromebook to your wifi network. You will only need to connect one time. The Chromebook will connect automatically after the first connection.

Step 5: Push the “Enter” key to complete the log in process.

Your student should now be able to navigate the Chromebook and complete his/her assignments.

Note: If you have difficulty, please contact your child’s teacher.

Students will not need to log in to Google. The Chromebook logs them in automatically.
