JOB GOAL: To serve the students attractive and nutritious meals in an atmosphere of

efficiency, cleanliness and warmth.

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Supervise and instruct kitchen personnel in the safe, proper, and efficient use of all kitchen equipment.

- 2. Maintain the highest standards of safety and cleanliness in the kitchen.
- 3. Provide food according to standardized recipes.
- 4. Determine the quantities of each food to be prepared daily.
- 5. Order all necessary food and supplies on a weekly basis.
- 6. Receive and verify orders.
- 7. Report immediately to the Principal any problem or accident occurring in the kitchen or the cafeteria premises.
- 8. Confer with the Principal, and Director of Child Nutrition on any personnel problems.
- 9. Maintain records as required by the Child Nutrition Program.
- 10. Participate in activities that promote good public relations with students, teachers and the community.

- 11. Supervise all cleaning.
- 12. Participate in activities that promote good public relations with students, teachers, and the community.
- 13. Supervise all banquets served in the school lunchroom.
- 14. Exhibit personal grooming and dress appropriately for food service.
- 15. Be regular and punctual in attendance.
- 16. Be familiar with and follow Alabaster City Schools Board of Education policies.
- 17. Maintain confidentiality of School System related business.
- 18. Perform other job-related duties that may be reasonably required by the Principal and the Director of Child Nutrition.

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: 190-day contract. Daily work schedule established by the Principal.
